Action Items:

- 1. Discuss and take action on letter of engagement from Gary Davis for the FY2018 Audit.
- 2. Discuss and take action on proposed contract from Technology for Education to a) perform higher level computer and server repairs and maintenance and b) complete special projects, to include budget amendments if necessary.
- 3. Discuss and take action on proposal to replace the irrigation pump for the landscaping to include budget amendments if necessary.
- 4. Discuss and take action on proposals from Library Interiors of Texas for new furnishings, to include budget amendments if necessary.
- 5. Discuss and take action on elections to include any adjustments for the 2018 election and the Joint Election Agreement with Travis County.

Faye moved, Jill seconded to proceed with action items as recommended. Unanimous approval.

- 6. Discuss and take action on draft 2019 Budget. Some discussion by the board the budget reflects increased revenue closer to recent actuals, added hours and staff. Ralph proposed adding \$100K more to materials/books. Board in agreement with more aggressive "weeding" of books under accepted standards to allow more room for desired books, understanding that space limitations will mean that a good portion of these funds will support electronic (mostly Overdrive) access.
 - Faye moved and Ralph seconded to increase "weeding" to remove books in excess of the current circulation development plan. Unanimous approval.
 - New line 527 was proposed for this \$100,000 supplemental. Ralph moved, Christine seconded a motion to accept the draft budget with this amendment. Unanimous approval
